What is Being Done and Traffic Impacts?

M-43 (Grand River Avenue)

Improvements between Coolidge Road and Park Lake Road include resurfacing 4 miles of roadway, intersection improvements and signal upgrades, as well as the addition of an 8-footwide pedestrian path on both sides of M-43 between Collingwood Drive and Brookfield Drive. Construction will be split into stages to minimize the impact on motorists and residents.

M-43 between Coolidge Road and Michigan Avenue and between Bogue Street and Park Lake Road

Construction is expected to begin on both the east and west ends of the project in early March. At least one lane of traffic will be open in each direction at all times during construction. There also may be intermittent sidewalk closures with a pedestrian detour posted. In addition, to minimize the impact on traffic, paving is expected to take place at night between Michigan Avenue and Park Lake Road along M-43.

M-43 between Michigan Avenue and Bogue Street

Construction along this section of M-43 also is expected to begin in early March, with at least one lane of traffic open in each direction. For a short period of time, starting in mid-May, all traffic will be shifted to either the westbound or eastbound side of M-43. This will allow the contractor to work on one side of M-43 at a time. It is anticipated that this traffic configuration will be in place for approximately one month.

M-143 (Michigan Avenue)

Improvements include resurfacing the roadway from just west of Harrison Road, east to the M-43 split. In addition, the intersections at Harrison Road and Beal Street will be reconfigured. Construction is expected to begin in March, with work complete by July.

MICHIGAN AVENUE

At least one lane of traffic will be open in each direction during construction.
